

WICCA GUIDE

Global Wicca Tradition

Wicca: A modern recognized religion of nature worship and magick that honors the universal energy in both god and goddess forms and upholds the belief that one should be free to intend or practice anything as long as it harms no-one (the Wiccan Rede – *An Harm Ye None Do As Ye Will*). **Wicca is not another name for general witchcraft.**

Wiccan Tradition: Wiccan faith is propagated by Wiccan Traditions who has certified and experienced Priests and Priestesses to guide you and has specific ritual method and technique to provide focused energy. A tradition provides education and training to its clergy (initiates), runs and manages Wiccan temples and creates proper awareness.

Global Wicca Tradition: The first public Wiccan tradition to originate in India and run by the Tarot India Network. Founder: Rev. Swati Prakash (Lady Astra Wishkap).

Earth Healing Temple: GWT's main temple dedicated to the Earth Goddess. Anyone can pray to the goddess at the temple or submit a healing request (positive wish) free of charge.

Magick: The registered retail brand of Tarot India Network and Global Wicca Tradition through which funds are raised to support the temple and its activities through services (readings, healings, rituals, spells) and products (amulets, talismans, crystals, gems, oils, candles, books, magickal tools and other spiritual healing products) www.supermagick.com

How to be a Wiccan: A Wiccan is someone who identifies with the religion of Wicca.

FREE WICCANING: You can be a Wiccan Follower by simply registering as one in our temple by signing The Wiccan Oath (included in this text). You do not have to convert or give up on your existing religion as Global Wicca is all encompassing and accepts all faiths as one. You can be a Wiccan and take the oath even if you are not taking up our courses. Initiation or Clergyhood is not mandatory to become a Wiccan follower in our tradition.

Witchcraft: Practice of magickal arts by any human including several spiritual practices and spells. Energy work such as Reiki and Pranic healing, shamanism, hypnotherapy, astral work, divination, feng shui, spiritual healing, astrological therapy, past life healing, poojas or worship of any kind as per any religion or belief can be thus termed witchcraft or craft of the wise as it involves magick (the art of creating outer change through spiritual or inner work and focused intention)

How to be a Witch: Everyone has a witch or wizard inside and needs to develop psychic (magickal) and healing powers to develop as a witch or wizard. You can take up our courses to develop this even if you do not intend to be initiated as Clergy

WICCA COURSES: Initiation as Clergy is not mandatory to access our courses. You can do any course just for your knowledge even if you do not wish to work for our temple as fully Initiated Priest/ Priestess.

No Black Magic: Harmful intentions and spells such as curses, malice, hate, sent consciously or even in the form of unconsciously spoken negative words such as 'go to hell', are avoided by a wise person or witch/wiz. Spells to attract, manipulate or control any person including Love spell to attract specific person towards you are not practiced by the Wise. Someone who practices black magic is not wise and cannot or should not be called a witch or wizard. They are simply foolish people who have not had the right spiritual training or else they would know that what goes around comes around through the law of nature. Our tradition looks down upon Black Magic and tries to bring people out of the same.

Solitary Witch: If you are a witch but not a follower of any Wiccan Tradition you may be a solitary witch but not a Wiccan. To be a Wiccan you must approach a Tradition of Wicca.

Ritual: A ceremony held under any tradition is called a ritual. Global Wicca Tradition hold rituals during Sabbats, selected Esbats and other important energy events for the purpose of Earth Healing.

Who can attend Rituals: Anyone can become a supporting member of Global Wicca Tradition through the annual fees and attend all rituals without additional costs, else an attendance fee to cover space and service cost will be applicable per guest. Some rituals are free for public and will be listed on our website www.globalwicca.com Events page. Only Clergy is allowed to conduct energy work and bring their wands. Guests and supporting members can observe and receive healing.

Sabbats: Wiccan festivals or holidays as scheduled by GWT for the northern hemisphere of the globe are

Samhain: 1st Nov (Wiccan New Year and end of summer) a major Sabbat

Yule: 21st Dec (Winter solstice or longest night) a Minor Sabbat

Imbolg or Candlemas: 1 Feb (recession of winter) a Major Sabbat

Ostara: 21 March (spring equinox when day equals night) a Minor Sabbat

Beltane: 1 May (start of summer) a Major Sabbat

Litha or Midsummer: 21 June (summer solstice or longest day) a Minor Sabbat

Lammas or Lughnasad: 1 Aug (recession of summer and first harvest) a Major Sabbat

Mabon: 21 Sep (autumn equinox when night equals day) a Minor Sabbat

Esbats: The new moons and full moons are also occasions for ritual and celebration especially wishing moons (full moons close to a Sabbat) and eclipses. These are variable from year to year.

Wiccan Clergy: Those who wish to practice Wicca as representatives of a Tradition take initiation into the tradition's temple to become a certified priest or priestess of the temple and are known as Reverend (Rev.) with their Craft name. The GWT follows a three degree system with courses, projects and assignments in each degree. Each degree has a one year and one day (101) probation period. You should take up initiation only if you wish to serve the temple and agree to actively take up some roles and responsibilities in the temple. Else you can simply take up the courses for information.

I understand that Global Wicca Tradition does not require me to give up on my existing religion or to take up formal initiation or courses to be recognized as Wiccan.

Above all I agree to the Wiccan Code of Ethics - the Wiccan Rede – “An Harm Ye None Do As Ye Will” understanding its meaning as ‘Harm None while making any intentions in the form of prayers, spells and rituals’.
